


OIL MARKET COMMENTARY

Price Adjustments and Forecasts

- Brent crude futures experienced a decline in May and early June, with prices falling by \$6/bbl in May.
- This trend continued into early June after OPEC+ announced plans to gradually unwind last year's extra voluntary output cuts starting in the fourth quarter of 2024.
- The U.S. Energy Information Administration (EIA) has adjusted its Brent spot price forecast to an average of \$84.15 per barrel for 2024, which is lower than the previous projection of \$87.79 per barrel.

Supply and Demand Dynamics

- Global oil supply rose by 520 kb/d in May to 102.5 mb/d, with non-OPEC+ production increases leading the way.
- World oil demand growth continues to slow, with 2024 gains now seen at 960 kb/d, which is 100 kb/d below last month's forecast

WINDOW OUTLOOK - 16TH JUNE 2024

For the June 16th, 2024 pricing window, petroleum product prices continue to decrease.

Crude Oil prices dropped by **-2.78%** for the period.

Consequently, international product prices of petrol, diesel, and LPG saw declines of -5.61%, -2.8%, and -1.5% respectively.




REGULATORY MARGINS

Some petroleum products are subject to various taxes, levies, and margins before reaching the consumer.

Crude Oil Market Dynamics

The cost of crude oil experienced a slight downtick, dropping from around \$81.27 per barrel (BBL) to \$79.33 per barrel, marking a 2.79% decrease.

This trend continued into early June after OPEC+ announced plans to gradually unwind last year's extra voluntary output cuts starting in the fourth quarter of 2024.

Product Prices on International Market

As a result, there has been an overall decline in the prices of refined products. Petrol, diesel, and LPG witnessed drops of -5.61%, -2.8% and -1.5% respectively.

Cedi Performance

During this period, the Ghanaian cedi continued its weakened state against the US dollar, depreciating by **3.59%** from 14.49 GHS to 14.99 GHS.

Ex-pump price projection

Subsequently, petrol and diesel price are expected to drop by **1.9%** and **1.1%** respectively at the pump.

Additionally, LPG prices are forecasted to remain unchange during this period.



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Figure 4: Year on year Average Ex-pump Prices (2023 - 2024)





From January to April 2024, the consumption of petroleum products has generally increased compared to the same period in the previous year.




Diesel - Monthly consumption 2023 vs 2024

Consumption has increased by 8% compared to 2023




LPG - Monthly consumption 2023 vs 2024

Consumption has increased by 14% compared to 2023










Premix - Monthly consumption 2023 vs 2024

Consumption has increased by 21% compared to 2023




MGO Local - Monthly consumption 2023 vs 2024

Consumption has increased by 159% compared to 2023




MGO Foreign - Monthly consumption 2023 vs 2024

Consumption has increased by 17% compared to 2023




Gasoil Mines - Monthly consumption 2023 vs 2024

Consumption has increased by 1% compared to 2023












Kerosene Monthly consumption 2023 vs 2024


